- **the metaverse** (noun) – *a virtual-reality space on the internet in which people interact with each other.*
- **virtual reality / VR** (noun) – *a computer-generated simulated experience that can be interacted with by a person using special equipment.*
- **augmented reality / AR** (noun) – *a computer-generated image superimposed on real-world objects to provide user interaction.*
- **avatar** (noun) – *the computer-generated representation of a user.*
- **virtual world** (noun) – *a computer-simulated world where people can enter as avatars and interact with each other.*
- **the real world** (noun) – *the world as it is, as opposed to a theoretical, simulated or idealistic world.*
